# **Benefits and Characteristics**

- Low odour aerosol formulation
- Will not alter coefficient of friction
- Slower drying; easy to work with
- Helps prevent permanent staining from oil and water-based stains

- Use on polished and unpolished surfaces

**Product Description:** Unique, low-odour impregnator/sealer aerosol formulation for use on both interior and exterior tile and masonry surfaces. Specifically formulated for polished surfaces such as porcelain, granite and marble, but is also excellent for use on sandstone, pavers and terracotta tiles.

**Directions for Application on Polished Porcelain, Marble or Granite:** Test in obscure area to determine suitability for the intended use. Surface should be clean, dry and free from any waxes, coatings, grout residue or finishes. The use of Sure Clean Porcelain cleaner is highly recommended for this purpose. Protect any painted or stained surface adjacent to the application area. Apply one good coat to the surface and grout lines by holding can approximately 15-20cm away from desired surface and spray slowly in a sweeping motion. For best results, leave to dry for a minimum of 1 hour, then re-apply a second coat to the area. Buff treated area (swiftly) before the second coat is dry using a rag or a woollen soft pad. For optimum results, avoid use of treated area for at least 5 hours (to allow for curing). Sure Seal® should only be used in open or well- ventilated areas, or when a suitable mask is worn.

**General Application Instructions for Grout, Tile or Masonry Products:** Test in obscure area to determine suitability for the intended use. Surface should be clean, dry and free from any waxes, coatings or finishes. Protect any painted or stained surface adjacent to application area. Apply one good coat to the surface and grout lines by holding can approximately 15-20cm away from desired surface and spray slowly in a sweeping motion. For best results, leave to dry for a minimum of 1 hour, then re-apply a second coat to the area. For optimum results, avoid use of treated area for at least 5 hours (to allow for curing). **Pre-Grout Sealer/Grout Release:** Sure Seal® can be used as a grout release prior to grouting to prevent grout stains and facilitate grout cleanup.

**Maintenance:** To clean treated areas, simply use water and mild detergent. There is no need to use harsh cleaning agents such as abrasive powders, ammonia, acids or bleach.

**Coverage:** Seals up to 550 linear metres depending on size of grout joint, or seals up to 20 square metres of tile and grout.

Quantities: Available in 300gram Aerosol cans, 12 cans to a carton.
